'Schools Bicycle Maintenance Class'



Our schools bike maintenance classes last for around two hours and cover removing a wheel from a bicycle and how to repair a puncture in an inner tube, adjusting gears and brakes and how to carry out a general check on a bike.

Up to twelve participants can take part and we want them to bring their own bike to work on but we can supply up to three bikes for those that don't have them.

We always carry a range of common spares such as cables and brake blocks which we will replace if needed on children's bikes.

Our mechanics previously delivered Bikeability Fix until funding was withdrawn.

Our mechanics are City & Guilds trained bicycle mechanics. Have current DBS checks, first aid & safeguarding training and insurance to carry out bike repairs.

Class for 12 children which can take place indoors or outdoors weather permitting.

We bring:
Two mechanics
Full tool kit
Workstands
Spares
Wheels/inner tubes/
tyres to practice
puncture repair

Cost of class: £350.00 within 20 mile radius of Chesterfield, Derbyshire.

Extra distance costs needed will be added.

All participants receive a selection of tools and puncture repair kit to take home.
